In her third New York solo show, Sheila Finnigan's new work attempts to highlight the life of George W. Bush from childhood through adulthood. Using found objects as a springboard for her paintings, her current show offers a Smithsonian-like presentation of Bush in works such as "Georgie-Porgy" a painting of Bush on his "first" rocking horse.

In the manner of Jacques Louis David's chaise portrait of "Madame Recamier", three large paintings depict Laura Bush ("Let Them Eat Cookies"), founding father George Washington, and a painting of George W. Bush as "George III", pictured above.
